Option 1 – World of the Pharaohs

World of the Pharaohs: Treasures of Egypt Revealed, presented by Harriet and Warren Stephens, Stephens Inc., World of the Pharaohs is on a limited North American tour: Little Rock is one of only four cities to receive this unique collection! *World of the Pharaohs* is the largest exhibition to ever visit Arkansas and the first of Egyptian art. The exhibition tells the story of life and culture in ancient Egypt. On view are more than 230 objects that span over 3,000 years of Egyptian life. *World of the Pharaohs* covers Egyptian civilization from the time before unification to Roman occupation. Option 2 – Mosaic Templars Cultural Center

Explore Arkansas's African American history, life, and culture in the new, state-of-the-art museum. Discover how black males and female business owners exemplified an entrepreneurial spirit. Explore the legacy of the Mosaic Templars of America, and learn more about black legislators in the 1890s. Listen to firsthand accounts of life in the segregated South from the people who lived the experience. Visit the Third Floor Auditorium and explore the Arkansas Black Hall of Fame. The museum is dedicated to collecting, preserving, interpreting, and celebrating African American history, culture and community in Arkansas from 1870 to the present, and informs and educates the public about black achievements – especially in business, politics and the arts.
